Dark & Delicious	5.0	Rich, dark and complex with an outstanding depth of flavour. Hopping is traditional using plenty of Fuggles.	
Cais	4.8	Cais means "Try" (as in rugby) in Welsh. This dark beer is for those who want rich flavours and balanced bitterness. Challenger hops are evident throughout.	
Carmen's Pulling Power	4.8	Hints of liquorice and caramel mingle with malty undertones to produce a fantastically drinkable ale.	
Carmen Sutra	4.4	A perfect blend of Pale Ale and Crystal malts marries no less than three hop additions of choicest Fuggles and Challenger hops. Golden brown in colour, this is the "must" Snowdonia signature beer.	
Cwrw Haf	4.2	A light golden, fruity/hoppy beer made with Styrian and Cascade hops.
